Details of the Laboratories, Animal House, and Herbal Garden for a Homeopathy College

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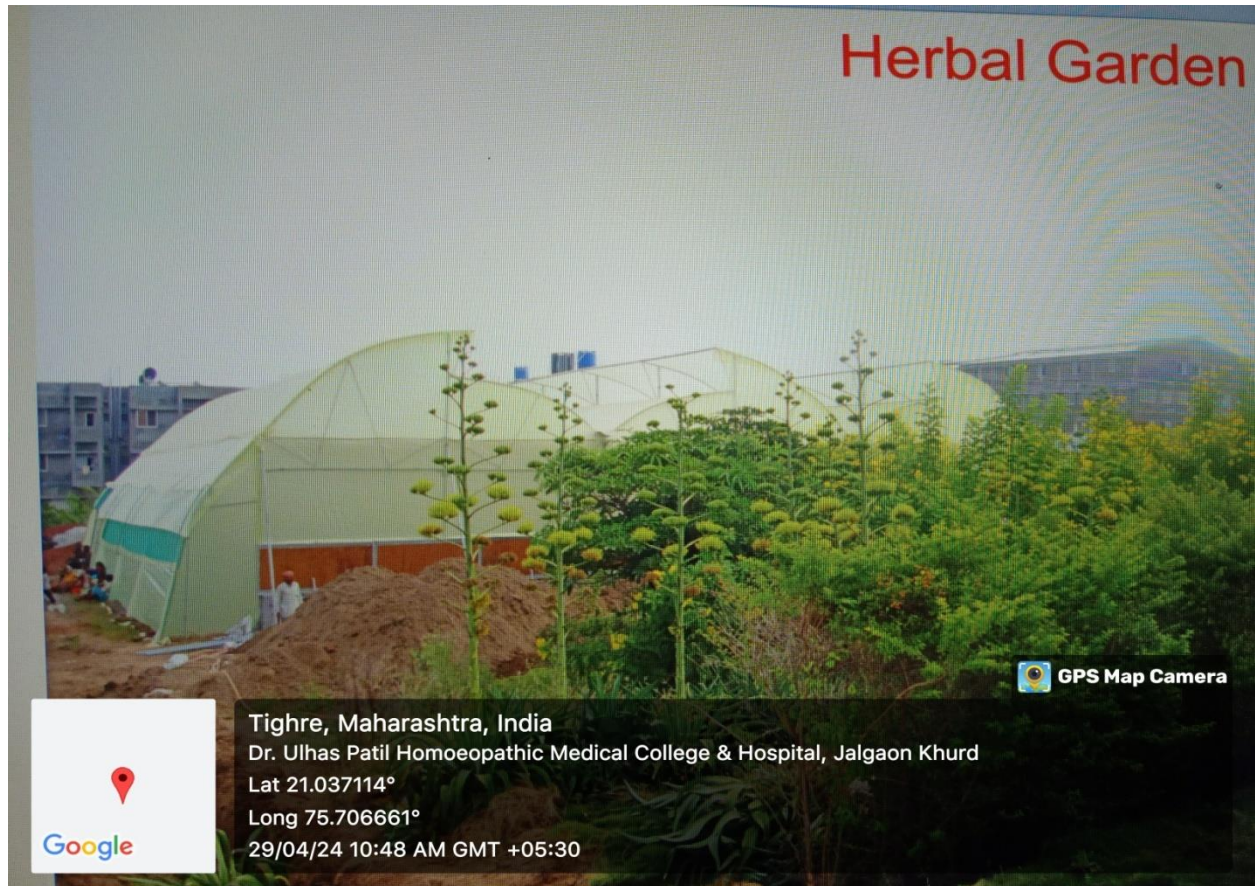
